Common permits required for forestry activities that might apply to my property (check all that apply):

- Timber Harvest Permit (CAL FIRE) - If you plan on harvesting and selling timber
- Waste Discharge Permit (Water Quality) - If your activities will result in soil or other material discharging to waterways
- Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (CDFW) - If activities alter lake or streambeds
- Grading Permit (County of Sonoma) - If you will build or modify a road or otherwise move soil
- Riparian Corridor Permit (Permit Sonoma) - If you are working near a riparian corridor
- You may also be interested in improving your property's structural hardening and defensible space, to comply with State Public Resources Code 4291
